Here's how you can help

 If you're around when the harassment happens, urge your child to continue playing if they want to, blocking or muting the offending player.

SHOULD I STOP MY KID FROM **PLAYING ONLINE GAMES (CONT)**

- If your kid tells you their experience, pay attention. Advise them that no one has the privilege to make them to feel awkward or uncomfortable.
- It's important to reassure them that you understand the way these digital spaces work, and just want to help them navigate them, not take them away.
- Tell them that harmful people want to ruin their game, and the best thing they can do is not let them.
